Call for Teaching: Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) Reporting

General information about the Winter School

The ENGAGE.EU Winter School ESG Reporting is an intensive, two-week winter programme with a mix of virtual and in-presence elements for master's students from all fields of studies, hosted by NHH Norwegian School of Economics in January 2026. Input will be given by lecturers of at least three ENGAGE.EU partner universities. The overall aim of the Winter School is to provide the students with state-of-the-art knowledge and skills on the topic of ESG Reporting.

Interdisciplinary academic exchange and intercultural experiences are central elements of the programme. In line with the general ENGAGE.EU goals, the students will be equipped with hard and soft skills needed to tackle societal challenges and act as responsible future leaders.

The Winter School ESG Reporting will take place from 5 to 16 January 2026. From 5 to 9 January, all teaching elements will be held online with several online lectures offered by lecturers at our partner universities. The physical part will take place from 12 to 16 January at NHH in Bergen, Norway. The language of instruction is English.

Teaching invitation for ENGAGE.EU faculty members

For the online part of the Winter School, NHH is recruiting members of faculty from ENGAGE.EU partner universities who would be interested in giving an online lecture on the theme of ESG Reporting. The lectures can be pre-recorded or live. The online lectures should take place between 5 and 9 January.

Members from any school or department of the ENGAGE.EU partners are welcome to hand in their application. The duration of an online lecture can be 90 to 180 minutes.

Key elements for teaching

- **Theme:** ESG Reporting
- **Credits:** 3 ECTS
- **Date online elements:** 5-9 January 2026
- **Participants:** 45-60 master's students from all fields of studies
- **Format:** Pre-recorded or live lectures
- **Duration:** 90-180 minutes per lecture
- **Remuneration:** NOK 3500 (approximately € 300) per online lecture

The lecture can focus on key perspectives, theoretical foundations, and concepts related to ESG reporting in organisations, with the ultimate goal of accelerating the adoption of sustainability goals. Lecturers will ideally have research and teaching broadly linked to the domain of Sustainability Accounting / Sustainability Reporting / Sustainability Communication & Strategy. Within this scope all ideas are welcome.
