European Master in Comparative, International and European Law (CIEL) Requirements

Eligibility for participation

Mobility in the CIEL network is open to UT1 students who have been selected into the **Master droit international et droit européen, parcours droit international et comparé** and have passed the Master 1, or been admitted directly into the Master 2.

Selection

Selection takes place mid-September in Toulouse. Applications include:

- a motivation letter specifying the destination wished for and, if applicable, 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} destination choices;

- a CV

- transcripts of records

- certificate for level in English (IELTS 6.5, TOEFL 90, or any equivalent) – this is a requirement of the CIEL partner universities

Requirements

For selected UT1 students, the mobility takes place in the 2nd academic semester. They follow their 1st semester at UT1 (**September – December**) and take the exams for their UEs there. They join the partner university in the 2nd semester, starting January.

Conditions to obtain the CIEL certificate

- The student must have **passed their Master 2 at UT1**. For the 2nd semester where they are on exchange at a partner university, their grade is the average they get on their **30ECTS**. This average is calculated after converting the grades obtained, following the conversion chart in use at UT1 for the host university, and validated by the directors of the Master 2.
- They must have spent the 2nd semester on an Erasmus exchange in one of the partner universities and passed **30 ECTS in courses** there.
- They must have completed a **Master's dissertation**, compliant with their home university's requirements (UE 5), with two supervisors, one from the host university and one from the host university, preferably in English although another language may be agreed upon by both supervisors. The supervisor at the host institution gives a pass/fail evaluation on the thesis, the final grade is issued by the home institution.

Nb: It is the student's responsibility to find both supervisors and ensure that the subject is approved by the home institution. During the 2nd semester at the host university, the advancement of the thesis should be followed with a professor of the host university, who should be identified and contacted as soon as possible after arrival. **Before departure, the student should fill in** the **CIEL dissertation document annexed,** so that the thesis research outline is ready before arrival at the host university. They may contact the local international coordinator at the host institution to help find a supervisor. They should meet at least twice with the supervisor at the host institution.

The co-supervisor must be met at least once during your stay in the host University. When the dissertation is sent, he shall send a report to Pierre EGEA, Lukas RASS-MASSON and Arnaud CHAN stating whether the student has met the requirements of a dissertation using a "pass" or "fail" grade.

It is necessary for the student to obtain a "pass" to obtain the CIEL certificate (in addition to graduating all **30 ECTS** in the host University).

If the aforementionned deadlines are not respected by the student, the CIEL certificate may not be delivered.
