


One of 43 European Agencies

 EU bodies with expertise in different subjects

Ex: justice and freedom, security and defense, business innovation, EU citizens wellbeing...

- Act upon request from EU commission or EU Member States
- Role: advise EU organisations and Member states, promote cooperation within the EU
- Concrete example: involvement of many EU agencies in the 2020-2021 pandemic



A brief history



EFSA, the European Food Safety Authority was established under **EU law in 2002** following a series of food crises as part of a programme to:

improve

the EU food safety system

help ensure

a high level of consumer protection

restore and maintain

confidence in the EU food supply

clearly separate

risk assessment and risk management functions









As a trainee, it was fascinating to be at the heart of the promotion of legality and regularity within the EU!


