The Master 1 * International and European Law (MIEL) is a French national program taught in English. It is aimed at providing students a strong knowledge of private and public aspects of international and European legal issues through a comparative perspective and at enhancing the legal methodology of the student. Finally, the MIEL will highlight the importance of the French legal methodology and the French language for international students.

* In the French system, the Master program is divided in two years: Master 1 (first year of Master) and Master 2 (second year of Master). It is possible to apply either for Master 1 or Master 2.

ACADEMIC OPPORTUNITIES

Students who obtain the MIEL degree may apply for a Master 2 program in France. Toulouse 1 Capitole University has Master 2 programs taught in English in the following specialities: International Business Law, International Economic Law, Private International Law.

ADMISSION

Admission Criteria

- a Licence degree or any three-year degree (or equivalent to 180 ECTS) in Law
- other specialisations (management, economics...) may be considered according to the profile of the candidate
- students may evidence by any means a good level of English.
