# Scholarships depending on your profile

If you are a CROUS scholarship holder

EUROPE & OUTSIDE OF EUROPE

+ International Mobility Aid (AMI)

Scholarship CROUS

+ Region Occitanie Grant OR ERASMUS+ Grant (only if eligible)

If you are NOT a CROUS scholarship holder

ERASMUS+ ZONE

ERASMUS+ Grant + Supplement Erasmus+ (if eligible)

OUTSIDE OF EUROPE -> Région Occitanie Grant (if eligible)



# You are a CROUS scholarship holder

## EUROPE & OUTSIDE OF EUROPE

### International Mobility Aid (AMI)\*

Student : L1 to M2 CROUS scholarship holder  
Gap year eligible

1 semester in Europe: 800 €

1 semester outside of Europe: 1 200 €

2 semesters in Europe geographic: 1 600 €

2 semesters outside of Europe: 2 000 €



### Region Occitanie Grant\*

Student : L2 to M2 CROUS scholarship holder  
Gap year **NO** eligible

Amount: 75€ per week

1 semester : 14 weeks max (ex. 75€ x 14 = **1 050 € max**)

2 semesters : 26 weeks max (ex. 75€ x 26 = **1 950 € max**)

# You are a CROUS scholarship holder

If you are studying in a country within the Erasmus+ zone and you meet one of the following criteria:

- If you have a disability or have a long-term illness (ALD) ;
- If you live at an address classified as Quartiers Prioritaires de la Ville ;
- If you are a **CROUS scholarship holder** (levels 6 and 7)

You are eligible to receive the **Erasmus+ grant** and **inclusion grant**.



# You are a CROUS scholarship holder

## ERASMUS+ Zone

### International Mobility Aid (AMI)\*

Student : L1 to M2 CROUS scholarship holder  
Gap year eligible

1 semester : **800€**  
2 semesters : **1600€**



### ERASMUS + Grant\*

Student : L2 to M2,  
Gap year **NO** eligible

- **Group 1** High cost of living : **360€**
- **Group 2 & 3** Medium & low cost of living : **310€**

1 semester = **3 monthly payments** (ex. 360 € x 3 = 1 080 € group 1)  
2 semesters = **6 monthly payments** (ex. 310 € x 6 = 1 860 € group 2)

United Kingdom excluded from the Erasmus+ grant



### Supplement Erasmus+ Grant\*

Inclusion Grant : 250€ / monthly in addition to the Erasmus+ grant  
(1 semester = 750 € ; 2 semesters = 1500 €)

### Supplement Erasmus+ Grant\*

Contribution to travel expenses : a flat-rate grant awarded only to students eligible for an Erasmus+ grant, calculated according to the scales below:

Distances	Standard means of transport	Green transport *
Between 100 and 499 km	211€	285 €
Between 500 and 1 999 km	309 €	417 €
Between 2 000 and 2 999 km	395 €	535 €

Student : L2 to M2,  
Gap year **NO** eligible

- **Group 1** High cost of living : **360€**
- **Group 2 & 3** Medium & low cost of living : **310€**

1 semester = **3 monthly payments** (ex.  $360 \text{ €} \times 3 = 1\,080 \text{ €}$  group 1)

2 semesters = **6 monthly payments** (ex.  $310 \text{ €} \times 6 = 1\,860 \text{ €}$  group 2)

United Kingdom excluded from the Erasmus+ grant

## OUTSIDE OF EUROPE (*United-Kingdom and Switzerland included*)

### Region Occitanie

### Grant

Student : L2 to M2,  
Gap year **NO** eligible

**Family income between 8 238 € and 20 000€.**

*The family income is calculated from the tax notice:  
Taxable income / number of units = Family income*

Amount: 75€ per week

1 semester : 14 weeks max (ex. 75€ x 14 = **1 050 € max**)

2 semesters : 26 weeks max (ex. 75€ x 26 = **1 950 € max**)

Student : L2 to M2 **CROUS** scholarship holder or not  
Gap year **NO** eligible  
Minimum mobility period of 6 weeks

Amount : **600 €**

- Japan
- Morocco

## Chèque Eurocampus

Student : M1 to M2 only, **CROUS** scholarship holder or not  
Gap year **NO** eligible  
Minimum mobility period of 6 weeks

Amount : **600 €**

- Catalonia
- Balearic Islands

## Aide au départ

Students with disabilities, **CROUS** scholarship holder or not

Amount : **600 €**

# The payment of grants :

**PLEASE NOTE** : Grants will be paid within 15 days of the start of your study mobility.

**NO monthly payment.**

**ERASMUS + Grant** and **Region Occitanie Grant** :

- payment of 80% after the reception of the certificate of beginning of your study mobility.
- 20% at the end of your study mobility

**International Mobility Aid (AMI)** : full payment (100 %) after the reception of the certificate of beginning of your study mobility.

# You are a CROUS scholarship holder

I am going to **Mexico** for **a semester**:

- **AMI : 1 200 €**
- **Region Occitanie Grant : 1 050 € maximum**
- **CROUS** scholarship

I am going to **Sweden** for **a year** (I am not eligible for the ERASMUS+ Grant) :

- **AMI : 1 600 €.**
- **Region Occitanie Grant : 1 950 € maximum**
- **CROUS** scholarship

I am going to **Spain** for **a year** and I'm a **CROUS scholarship levels 6** (I am eligible for the ERASMUS+ Grant) :

- **AMI : 1 600 €.**
- **ERASMUS + Grant** and the **Inclusion Grant 3 360 €**  
(= 310 € x 6 monthly payments + 250 € x 6 monthly payments )
- **CROUS** scholarship



# You are not a CROUS scholarship holder

## ERASMUS+ ZONE

I'm going to **Spain** for a **semester** (to Madrid) by train :

- **ERASMUS+ grant** ( $310 \text{ €} \times 3 \text{ monthly payments} = 930\text{€}$ )
- **The contribution to travel expenses green transport** (417€)

**Total = 1 347€**

(+ inclusion grant if eligible ,  $250 \text{ €} \times 3 = 750 \text{ €}$ )

I'm going to **Ireland** for a **year** by plane :

- **ERASMUS+ grant** ( $360 \text{ €} \times 6 \text{ monthly payments} = 2160 \text{ €}$ )
- **The contribution to travel expenses standard means of transport** (309 €),

**Total = 2 469€**

(+ inclusion grant if eligible ,  $250 \text{ €} \times 6 = 1 500 \text{ €}$ )

## **OUTSIDE OF EUROPE** (*United-Kingdom and Switzerland included*)

I'm going to the **United Kingdom** for a **year** :

I can receive the **Region Occitanie Grant** (**1 950 € max**)

*If my family income is between 8 238 € and 20 000 €.*
