# From 6th to 9th, June Module 3 "Bootcamp" : Challenges

#### **Hector Le Collector**

The project is designed to allow everyone to recycle their food waste, even those who live in a 20 m2 apartment in the city centre.

Hector recovers all bio-waste. NOTHING is lost, EVERYTHING is transformed, to produce responsible energy as well.

Hector the Collector's current business model relies heavily on collection points, mainly big companies (who pay for a collection bin): this generates a problem of blocked volumes because the more the point collects, the more it pays.

#### **Challenge:**

How can we motivate as many people as possible to recycle their food waste and achieve a change of scale, without penalising either the collection points or the structure's margin?

#### Ô Mazettes - Le Lieu d'A Côté

The non profit association Ô Mazettes is a collaborative grocery shop created on 2019 by several inhabitants of the district des Mazades in Toulouse.

The project was defined by taking into account the demands of the inhabitants and is intended to be participatory and democratic.

It is rooted in the area and is based on the opportunities that arise :

the adjoining premises became available in 2022. An association has been set up to make it a space open to the inhabitants : Le Lieu d'A Côté.

Exhibitions, concerts, etc. may be organised by the inhabitants of the district in this new place. The rent for this space and the charges are currently financed by the association  $\hat{O}$  Mazettes.

#### <u>Challenge</u>:

How to make Le Lieu d'A Côté a solidarity space animated by and for the people of the neighbourhood while being economically autonomous?
