Christina Deliyanni-Dimitrakou is a graduate of the Law School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. Following her postgraduate studies in International Private Law and International Social Law at the Law Faculty of the University of Geneva (Switzerland), she obtained her PhD diploma from the same University. She is an Associate Professor at the Law School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, where she teaches Comparative Law and European Social Law at undergraduate and postgraduate level as well as in the framework of the faculty's Erasmus Programme. She has been a visiting professor at the Law Faculties of Dijon and Toulouse (France), she is a member of the International Academy of Comparative Law, of the French Society of Comparative Legislation and of the Greek Society of Labor Law and Social Security. Since 2011 she also one of the co-directors of the Franco-Hellenic Master which operates at the Law Faculties of the Universities of Thessaloniki and Toulouse Capitol 1.

Prof. *Deligianni-Dimitrakou* is also a member of the International Academy of Comparative Law, of the French Society of Comparative Law of the Greek Society of Labour Law and Social Security, of Thessaloniki Bar Association and of other scientific bodies. Additionally in December 2013 she became a member of the Academic Network on the European Social Charter and Social Rights headed by Prof Jean-François AKANDJI-KOMBÉ and manages the establishment and coordination of the Greek wing of the network.
