

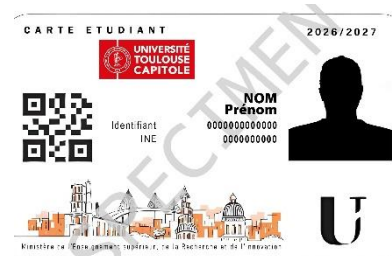
Enrolment from 1 st to July 17, 2026	Test available from July 21 to August 30, 2026 included
Enrolment from August 22 to August 28, 2026	Test available from September 1 st to September 3 rd , 2026 included
Enrolment from August 31, 2026	Test available only in CRL from August 31, 2026

This test takes about 30 minutes. You should have your UT Capitole student number and a headset, earphones or speakers for the listening comprehension. You will need a computer or a tablet. The test is not compatible with smartphones. The use of Google Chrome is recommended.

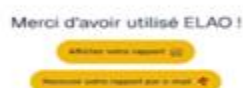
You will be evaluated on 4 modules: grammatical structures, vocabulary, reading comprehension and listening comprehension.

1. Click on the following link to access the test (do not use a smartphone): <https://univ-toulouse.elao.online/fr>
 2. Choose the language used to display the menus and instructions (this is not the language of the test): FR or EN (French or English)
- To evaluate your level of Spanish or German*, enter your access code:
UT-26- followed by the last 8 digits of the student number
for example: your student card identity number is **0110022456789**
your test code is **UT-26-22456789**

** Spanish-speaking students must select German and German-speaking students must select Spanish and other students have the choice.*



- To evaluate your level of French*, enter your access code:
UT-26- followed by the last 8 digits of the student number + LV2
for example : your student card identity number is **0110022556789**
your test code is **UT-26-22556789LV2**
- * Only for non European students of the first year.*
3. Enter your **Surname, First name** and **Email address**, then tick the privacy settings
 4. Choose the language to be evaluated and follow the instructions on the screen.
Note: Do not copy the entire sentence if not requested.
 5. At the end of the test, you obtain a score: send it to yourself by email. Your score will be automatically sent to the university administrator.
