



**INSTRUCTIONS FOR TAKING THE COMPULSORY ELAO LEVEL TESTS**  
**SPANISH OR GERMAN**  
**BSc1-BSc2-BSc3 TSM**

Enrolment from July 3 <sup>rd</sup> to July 18 <sup>th</sup>	Test available from July 20 <sup>th</sup> to August 30 <sup>th</sup> included
Enrolment from August 24 <sup>th</sup> to August 30 <sup>th</sup>	Test available from September 2 <sup>nd</sup> to September 6 <sup>th</sup> included

**This test takes about 30 minutes. You should have your Toulouse Capitole University student number and a headset, earphones or speakers for the listening comprehension. You will need a computer or a tablet. The test is not compatible with smartphones.**

**You will be evaluated on 4 modules: grammatical structures, vocabulary, reading comprehension and listening comprehension.**

1. Click on the following link to access the test (do not use a smartphone): <https://univ-toulouse.elao.online/fr>
2. Choose the language used to display the menus and instructions (this is not the language of the test) : FR or EN (French or English)

- To evaluate your level of Spanish or German\*, enter your access code:  
**UT-24- followed by the last 8 digits of the student number**  
for example : your student card identity number is **0110022456789**  
your test code is **UT-24-22456789**  
*\* Spanish-speaking students must select German and German-speaking students must select Spanish and other students have the choice.*



- To evaluate your level of French\*, enter your access code:  
**UT-24- followed by the last 8 digits of the student number + LV2**  
for example : your student card identity number is **0110022456789**  
your test code is **UT-24-22456789LV2**  
*\* Only for non European students.*



3. Enter your **Surname, First name** and **Email address**, then tick the privacy settings
4. Choose the language to be evaluated and follow the instructions on the screen.  
Note: Do not copy the entire sentence if not requested.
5. At the end of the test, you obtain a score: send it to yourself by email. Your score will be automatically sent to the university administrator.
