# GETTING TO TOULOUSE

## **Arrival at Toulouse Blagnac Airport**

Toulouse-Blagnac Airport is well connected to major European cities. Airlines such as Air France, British Airways, Lufthansa, KLM, Iberia, and Swiss operate regular flights. Additionally, low-cost airlines like Ryanair, EasyJet, and Volotea offer budget-friendly options.

From the airport, you can reach the city center with the airport shuttle or with a taxi.

## **Arrival at Matabiau train or bus station**

The Matabiau Station is connected to major French cities, including Paris and Bordeaux, as well as Occitanie cities with high-speed trains (TGV), intercity trains (Intercité) and regional trains (TER).

Buses to major French and European cities also stop at the bus station which is adjacent to the train station.

The train and bus stations are located in the North-Eastern part of the city center. They are easily accessible with the metro (line A) and several bus lines.



# GETTING AROUND

## Metro

There are two metro lines in Toulouse: Line B, which connects the North and the South of Toulouse, and Line A, which connects the West and the East of Toulouse. Both lines stop at several stations in the city center.

## Tramway

Line T1 connects the city center to the North-Western part of Toulouse.

## Téléo

Téléo is three kilometres long, making it the longest urban aerial tramway ever built in France. It takes passengers from the Oncopole Institute to Paul Sabatier University via Rangueil Hospital in just 10 minutes.

### TICKETS

You can buy a ticket in the Tisséo mobile app, at an automatic ticket dispenser, on the bus, or on the airport shuttle.

A single ticket for the metro, tramway, bus and téléo costs 1,80 € and allows to travel on the whole Tisséo network (metro, bus, tram, téléo) for 1 hour after the ticket is first validated.

A single airport shuttle ticket costs 9 € and allows for 3 changes on 4 different lines (shuttle, metro, bus, tram) during the 1h30 after the ticket is first validated.

## Airport shuttle

A shuttle goes from Toulouse Blagnac Airport to the city center and the Toulouse Matabiau train station every 15 minutes. The journey takes around 25 minutes.

## Bus

More than a hundred bus lines connect all parts of Toulouse.


## VélôToulouse

# PRACTICAL INFORMATION



## Weather

Toulouse has an oceanic and Mediterranean-influenced climate. Winters are mild, with temperatures ranging from 5°C to 12°C, while summers can be hot, often reaching 30°C or more. Spring and autumn offer pleasant weather with occasional rain. The local weather forecast can be found on [meteofrance.com](http://meteofrance.com).



## Currency

The currency in France is the Euro (€). ATMs are widely available, and credit cards are accepted in most places. Currency exchange services are available at the airport and in the city center. Exchange rates may vary, check with your bank or exchange provider for the latest rates.



## Language

The official language in Toulouse is French. English is commonly spoken in tourist areas, hotels, and by younger generations. Spanish is also frequently understood due to the city's proximity to Spain.

# TOURISM



## Historical and Cultural Sights

**The Capitole** | The emblematic building of Toulouse. Standing on the very popular Place du Capitole, it houses both the Town Hall and the Théâtre du Capitole.

**The Basilica of Saint-Sernin** | One of the largest Romanesque buildings in the western world. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

**The Jacobins Convent** | A medieval monastery with an impressive palm-tree-shaped ceiling.

**Les Abattoirs Museum** | A modern and contemporary art museum that took up residence in the former slaughterhouses of the city of Toulouse.



## Outdoor activities

**The Banks of the River Garonne** | Walk along the Promenade Henri-Martin and at the Place de la Daurade and enjoy one of the most beautiful views of the city which features the Pont Neuf, the Hôtel-Dieu Saint-Jacques, and the dome of La Grave.

**Jardin des Plantes** | A beautiful botanical garden, perfect to enjoy a stroll or have a picnic.

**Prairie des Filtres** | A venue for picnics, get-togethers and culture, that stretches out from the Pont Neuf to the Pont Saint-Michel.

**Canal du Midi** | A UNESCO-listed waterway, ideal for a scenic boat trip, a bike ride or a walk along the banks.



## Science and Discoveries

**Cité de l'Espace** | An interactive space museum with full-scale rockets.

**Aerospopia Museum** | Explore legendary aircrafts, such as the Concorde and the Airbus A380.

**Quai des Savoirs** | An interactive science museum where you can touch, test, and experiment.

**Jolimont Observatory** | An observatory where it is possible to come stargazing every Friday evening.



## Day trips from Toulouse

**Carcassonne** | A unique and UNESCO-listed fortified city where you can explore medieval life and Occitan culture.

**Foix** | This medieval town nestled at the foot of the Pyrennees is the starting point for many beautiful hiking trails

**Albi** | The Episcopal City is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and hosts two of the world's largest red brick monuments: the Berbie Palace and the Sainte-Cécile Cathedral.

**Fronton Vineyards** | Discover the 2,400 hectares Fronton Vineyards, which produces an emblematic wine from a grape unique in France, Negrette, using sustainable farming practices.

## Venues

**Halle de la Machine** | Discover the show machines of the company La Machine set in motion by the Veritable Machinists. A permanent show between street theater art and mechanics.

**Cinémathèque de Toulouse** | The second biggest film library in France. It organises a wide diversity of events and screenings all year long.

**Théâtre de la Cité** | A theater that programs plays, dance, circus and other performing arts events.

**Opéra du Capitole** | There you can see an opera, a ballet or listen to a lyrical concert.

**La Cabane** | In the hybrid space called Les Halles de la Cartoucherie, in the heart of a new ecodistrict, La Cabane is a theater that partners with local artists to propose all kinds of performing arts events.

**American Cosmograph | ABC** | Arthouse cinemas where you can see both French movies and foreign movies in original version with French subtitles.

**La Halle au Grain** | A symphonic concert hall where you can listen to the Orchestre National du Capitole.

**Metronum** | A concert hall dedicated to contemporary music.


